

NOTICE OF MAKING PUBLIC HIGHWAY STOPPING UP ORDER
SECTION 116 HIGHWAYS ACT 1980, RUTLAND COUNTY COUNCIL

STOPPING UP ORDER – 3 TOP STREET, WING, RUTLAND

Notice is hereby given that Rutland County Council, the Highway Authority for the area of highway land referred to in the Schedule hereto, intends to apply to the Magistrates' Court, Bridge Street, Peterborough on the 2nd November 2016 at 10am for an Order under Section 116 of the Highway Act 1980 that the area of highway land referred to in the Schedule shall be stopped up for the purposes of all traffic so that the same shall cease to be highway on the grounds that it is unnecessary.

A plan ("the Order Plan") showing edged red the area of highway land to which the application relates may be seen free of charge at Rutland County Council, Council Offices, Catmose, Oakham, LE15 6HP during normal opening hours.

Any person who has an interest in the land abutting on or served by the said area of highway land or uses the area of highway land or is otherwise aggrieved has a right to be heard by the Court on the Hearing of the application by the Council.

Any person intending to attend the Hearing of this application is requested to inform the Senior Highways Manager, Rutland County Council, Council Offices, Catmose, Oakham, LE15 6HP (Quoting reference 096896 – Top Street) before the date of the Hearing of their intention to appear.
